LURE COURSING TESTS

JC TEST RUNS: Open to all hounds of an eligible breed. A hound, at least 12 mo of age, running alone shall receive a certification from a Judge on one date and a second certification from a different Judge at a later date, stating that the hound completed a 600 yd course with a minimum of four (4) turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

QC TEST RUNS: Open to all hounds of an eligible breed. A hound at least 12 mo of age (Qualifying Hound) running with another hound of the same breed or another breed with a similar running style (Testing Hound) shall receive certification from a licensed judge, stating that the hound completed a 600 yd course with a minimum of four (4) turns. The hound must complete the course with enthusiasm and without interruption.

The handler presenting the Qualifying Hound shall be responsible for providing the Testing Hound for the qualifying course. It is recommended that every Qualifying Hound practice with other hounds prior to being presented for a qualifying courser test.

LURE COURSING TRIAL

OPEN STAKE: Open to hounds that have obtained an AKC Qualified Courser Certificate, an ASFA Field Champion Title, or a CKC Field Champion Title. Hounds that have earned an AKC Field Champion Title are not eligible to enter the Open Stake. Points earned will only count toward a FCh title.

SPECIAL STAKE: Open to hounds that have earned their AKC Field Champion Title. Champion points earned from Specials Stake will count toward LCX titles. Qualifying scores earned will count toward SC and MC titles.

OPEN VETERAN STAKE: Open to hounds that are eligible to enter the Open or Special Stakes and have reached 6 years of age on the day of the trial, except Irish Wolfhounds at 5 years of age, Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis and Whippets at 7 years of age. Championship points will be awarded. Points earned may count toward either a FCh title or LCX title.

SINGLE STAKES: Open to all hound breeds approved to participate in AKC lure trials. Hounds with breed disqualifications are eligible to enter. Hounds entered in Singles shall not be allowed to enter the regular stakes (open, specials, veterans) at the same event

ELIGIBLE BREEDS AND REGISTRY: Only purebred Afghan Hounds, Azawakhs, Basenjis, Borzoi, Cirnechi dell'Etna, Greyhounds, Ibizan Hounds, Irish Wolfhounds, Italian Greyhounds, Norrbottenspets*, Peruvian Inca Orchid*, Pharaoh Hounds, Portuguese Podengo Pequeno, Portuguese Podengos* (med & grnd), Rhodesian Ridgebacks, Salukis, Scottish Deerhounds, Sloughis, Thai Ridgebacks* and Whippets that are one year of age or older and have been registered with the American Kennel Club, the AKC Foundation Stock Service, an AKC recognized foreign registry or that have been granted an Indefinite Listing Privilege (ILP) may be entered.

**Norrbottenspets, Portuguese Podengo (Medio & Grande), Peruvian Inca Orchid, and Thai Ridgebacks may only compete for suffix titles.*

Portuguese Podengo Pequenos are ineligible to compete for BIF

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. All entries must be one year of age or older on day of event
2. Hounds not present at the time of roll call will be scratched after a 5 minute grace period.
3. Each entry will be examined at inspection for breed disqualifications.
4. Bitches in season, hounds with breed disqualifications and lame hounds will be excused and have their entry fees refunded.
5. Spayed and neutered hounds, without breed disqualifications, may be entered.
6. Monorchid and cryptorchid hounds are eligible to participate.
7. All hounds will run twice, in trios, if possible, or braces unless excused, dismissed or disqualified.
8. Each course will be reversed for the final runs and reversed again for the Best of Breed run.
9. Gas powered continuous loop lure machine will be used. The lures will consist of plastic strips. Backup equipment will be available.
10. A \$5 fine will be assessed for loose hounds during courses in progress.
11. A \$20 fine will be assessed for failing to clean up their dogs' waste.
12. Please bring your own food, shade and water. There is no running water available at the site.
13. No one, except Field Committee members, will be allowed on the field without the expressed permission of the Field Chairman.
14. Anyone exhibiting unsportsmanlike conduct will be excused from the field for the day.
15. Please clean up your set-up area, a trashcan will be provided.
16. AHGA assumes no liability for injury to any person or dog before, during or after the Tests and Trials.
17. AHGA cannot predict the time needed to complete this event and it may last for the duration of daylight hours.
18. A port-a-potty will be on sight.
19. Muzzles are optional

There is NO running water or electricity available.

DIRECTIONS

From Anchorage: Take Glenn Hwy North toward Palmer. Once past the Parks Hwy interchange, follow directions below.

From Fairbanks/ Wasilla: Take Parks to Glenn Hwy. Head North on Glenn to Palmer. Red Gate of the Fairgrounds will be on the right. Head east across the parking area to Red Gate. Rebarchek Field will be on the right, just south across from the Red Gate. Look for trial signs.

From Palmer: South of Palmer on Glenn Hwy. Fairgrounds Red Gate entrance will be on the left. Drive across parking lot, east to Red Gate. Rebarchek Field will be on the right, just south across from the Red Gate. Look for trial signs.
